250 **RECREATION GROUNDS INSPECTION REPORT**

251 **RIVERSIDE INTERPRETATION BOARDS (Min 180 - 12.01.10)**

Cllr Wheeler submitted a report, a copy of which had been circulated to each Member and a copy of which appears as **Appendix B** to these Minutes in the Minute Book.

The report presented the results of his survey of the existing boards on the River Allen. He added that he had omitted one board which was sited between the end of Mill Lane and the Somerfield Car Park which he had since seen and which was in need of refurbishment, along with the one in Eastbrook Row mentioned in his report.

Cllr Bartlett said that some of the boards were orientated incorrectly and if possible should be repositioned.

252 REDCOTTS RECREATION GROUND - TOILETS & STORAGE
