1 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972 - SECTION 249 HONORARY FREEDOM OF WIMBORNE MINSTER - THE RIFLES REGIMENT

To consider granting to the Rifles Regiment the freedom of Wimborne Minster.

(Note: Section 249(7) to (9) of the 1972 Act (as amended) states:

- (7) The power (to admit the honorary freedom) is exercisable by resolution of the relevant authority.
- (8) A resolution under subsection (7) above must be passed -
 - (a) at a meeting of the relevant authority which is specially convened for the purpose and where notice of the object of the meeting has been given; and
 - (b) by not less than two-thirds of the members of the relevant authority (or, in the case of charter trustees, of the trustees) who vote on it.
- (9) A relevant authority may spend such reasonable sum as it thinks fit for the purpose of presenting an address or a casket containing an address to on whom the authority has conferred the title.)
