216 **RIVERSIDE FACILITY – ELECTRICITY AND WATER SUPPLY**

The Town Clerk submitted a report, a copy of which had been circulated to each Member and a copy of which appears as **Appendix A** to these Minutes in the Minute Book.

Dreamboats had asked the Town Council to consider funding the cost of installing a bollard at the District Council's Riverside facility to enable the safe access to water and electricity by event organisers.

Members felt that it was a pity that the District Council could not provide the necessary funding. The £1,500 requested would be a small proportion of the overall cost of the scheme and Members were disappointed that the District Council would not properly finish the
