




### Leigh Park

We have been involved in discussions with Christchurch & East Dorset District Council and Wimborne Rugby Club regarding the provision of new sports pitches on land to the south of Leigh Road. The development includes some provision for football which is of interest to us but clearly this initiative provides for the re-location of Wimborne Rugby Club. Whilst we understand that new facilities will not be available for 2 or 3 years we would like to be considered as successors to Wimborne Rugby Club as tenants of Leigh Park.

Following the recent discussions our Committee has decided to prepare a strategy for future development of the club and Leigh Park would be a perfect centre for this. Should the facilities at Leigh Park be available it would be our intention to make provision for football for all ages and both genders and not solely two adult pitches.
