	from Wessex Water did not attend the meeting.

	restricting the movement of HGVs with gross weight of more than 7.5 tonnes
	passing through the town in contravention of the weight limit restrictions. The
	Chairman asked if it was possible to use the towns CCTV to record the
	vehicle registration numbers and log movements and forward to the Police.
